KNOW YOUR OPTIONS

STEP 1



Start asking the question:
Do I qualify?

STEP 2



Visit the website for more information on various Aid options to see if its right for you

STEP 3



Create a checklist of their requirements vs your position to confirm if you qualify

STEP 4



Make sure you have your documentation ready when completeing the forms

STEP 5



Submit your application before the closing date

SMALL BUSINESS RELIEF FUND OFFERS INTEREST FREE LOANS TO SMALL BUSINESSES IN THE SOUTH AFRICAN JEWISH COMMUNITY ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY THE IMPACTS OF COVID-19

STEP 1



Businesses must be tax and regulatory compliant; must not be engaged in the weapons, gambling, sex or narcotics industries and not linked to any politically exposed persons

STEP 2



To lend to majority Jewish owned small businesses that were intrinsically healthy prior to the crisis and now face financial hardship

STEP 3



Available as a last resort lender for applicants who have considered and pursued all other options.

STEP 4



Offering interest free loans to small businesses in the South African Jewish community adversely affected by the impacts of COVID-19.

Rambam Trust

STEP 1



Who qualifies?
Any member of the South African Jewish community

STEP 2



For families in urgent need of an interest free loan of up to R10 000. No surety required. Repayment by means of 12 monthly equal debit orders.

STEP 3



Funds are extremely limited and will be allocated based on the recipient's particular situation/need.

STEP 4



Make sure you have your documentation ready when completing the forms

THE CAPE TOWN JEWISH EMERGENCY RELIEF SCHEME (CTJERS) IS A LOAN SCHEME FOR MEMBERS OF THE WESTERN CAPE COMMUNITY WHO WERE SUSTAINABLY EMPLOYED UP TO THE START OF COVID-19 LOCKDOWN

WHO?



Those who prior to the lockdown earned more than R10,000 per month and are now suffering financial hardship due to their income being greatly diminished by the COVID crisis.

WHAT?



The scheme has been designed to provide bridge interest-free loan funding for people whose monthly earnings have been significantly affected through the lockdown. T & Cs apply.

SPECIFICS?



An important principle of CTJERS funding is providing a mix of financial and non-financial assistance to support affected people to get through the COVID crisis.

HOW?
